Our men's singles players, Daniel Plant and Rohan Kapoor, were both on good form successfully winning their matches in straight sets. Emma Skingsley, playing at top singles, performed superbly to beat Steph Pound in three close sets. Sue Crompton had a similarly close game against Bryony Morris, only just missing out 20-22 in the final set.

The men's doubles matches were always going to be tough. Our top doubles pair of Chris Dakin and Mark Law played particularly well to win both their games in three sets. Their first match against Will Hilton-Jackson and Colin Dow gave spectators a treat with Chris and Mark snatching a 23-21 victory in the final end. The second men's pair of Lee Scott and Ben Barber had a disappointing weekend losing both their games. As a result of splitting the men's doubles matches, the score was 5-3.

The 2nd team prides itself on having a strong selection of ladies to choose from. Even though the team was down two of their usual players, we were able to call on the very successful veterans pairing of Viv Gillard and Sue Crompton. Both pairs of Karina Bryant and Nicola Waller and Viv and Sue had straight forward wins over the Sussex 2nd pair. Karina and Nicola also claimed a victory in straight sets against the Sussex 1st pair of Steph Pound and Karen Arscott, although the second set went to the wire: 22-20.
